

LIST OF ITEMS YOU WILL NEED FOR GARDENING

9 VOLT BATTERY (the square battery) – find at any store or the Garden sells them for \$5 each

U SHAPED GROUND OR SOD STAPLES – to hold down the poly pipe and the drip lines; available at any hardware or home improvement center; I got mine through Amazon



SOIL AMENDMENTS: Composted Steer Manure, Happy Frog organic fertilizer, Kellogg Soil Amend, Mushroom Compost, Azomite Mineral supplement (all garden beds using organic potting soil will need to add minerals; after vegetation is composted into organic soil it lack minerals). Azomite is available at our local Ace Hardware store in the gardening section; this goes on top of the bed after everything else is mixed into the potting soil and watered well. Water in the Azomite to activate it into the soil. For your plants -- Mix to spray -- Amazing Dr. Zymes Eliminator for pesky bugs.

SHADE COVER – The garden provides the shade covers; please contact a garden manager to check one out for your garden bed. The covers are numbered. If the cover is lost or blows away in a storm (because you did not affix it securely) it will cost \$25 to replace the cover.

TOOLS – the garden provides some tools. If a garden manager is not available to unlock the tool shed, you should have some basic tools with you when you come to the garden. Scissors, garden pruners, hand trowel, hand cultivator tool, Spray bottle or pump sprayer.

TRASH BAGS – you should always have one or two trash bags so that you can take home your garden debris and litter.

5 GALLON BUCKET or tool bag – to hold all your tools and miscellaneous stuff.

GLOVES – comfortable work gloves are a must. **Don't forget a HAT!**

CONCRETE LADDERS – THE WIRE HOOPS THAT WE USE IN THE GARDEN BEDS – Home Depot carries the galvanized wire ladders; they won't rust. We give you 3 of the 4" wide hoops; if you want more you have to buy them. They are all 10' long and arch quite nicely across the bed. Use some of the narrow style wire hoops to secure your hoops across the top so they don't blow over in a wind storm.

- *AGAVE, SUCCULENTS OR CACTI
- *MARIJUANA
