



# Fountain Hills Community Garden Rules



## Do

Keep the area around your bed clean and free of weeds and avoid letting your plants spill over into the adjoining bed or the aisle way.

Store all of your tools, hose, amendments etc. inside your garden bed.

Please remove trash from your bed and dispose of it at home.

Visitors to the garden must be accompanied by a Garden Member.

Children must be supervised at all times and at their own beds with an adult.

Please respect the property and space of other gardeners.

Gate must remain closed at all times.

Never share your gate code.

Return all borrowed tools and books.

Do close your bed down if you will not be attending it for 3 weeks or more and please notify a garden manager.

Volunteer...many hands make light work.

Be respectful of gardeners and garden.

Do put items away, if you see they are out of place.

## Don't

NEVER EVER affix anything to your garden bed - no nails, no screws, nothing.

Never remove anything from another gardener's bed.

Don't use your neighbor's garden hose.

Turn off and recoil all hoses after use.

No pets in the Garden.

Don't turn off your neighbor's water or timer, unless they have a leak. Then call a manager immediately.

Do not plant the following plants in your garden bed:

Mint (very invasive, please plant at home)

Fruit trees or fruit bushes

Agave, Cacti and Succulents

Marijuana Plants

Palm trees

Any types of trees or shrubs

If you see any Mesquite or PaloVerde sprouts, please remove them.

There are NO PAID CARETAKERS in the garden...everyone works on a VOLUNTEER basis. Please be responsible for the care and maintenance of your bed. If there is a recurring problem in the garden that is bugging you, please contact a manager.
